Weekending 20th April 2019

In this week's Premier Division Penlan 'A' wrapped up the title for the second year running with a 30-0 victory over Carmarthen 'C' who were treated to a spectacular show of power by Penlan from Marc Castro (who also won the divisional averages), Jarrett Zhang and Josh Morgan.

Penlan 'C' cemented second place by beating already relegated Cam Gears 'B' 29-7 with Ben Mora winning 9-0 and Jacob Young 9-1.
